



We can **disagree** without being **disagreeable**

*What is disagreeing agreeably?*

- It's **holding convictions** that are **different** than “the other”

*One person considers one day more sacred than another; another considers every day alike. Each of them should be fully convinced in their own mind.*

ROMANS 14:5 NIV

- It's **talking** about our **convictions** without the **pressure to persuade** “the other”

*Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.*

COLOSSIANS 4:6 NIV

- It's **finding common ground** with “the other”

*“People of Athens! I see that in every way you are very religious. For as I walked around and looked carefully at your objects of worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: to an unknown god. So you are ignorant of the very thing you worship—and this is what I am going to proclaim to you.”*

ACTS 17:22-23 NIV

- It's **moving relationally toward** “the other”
